Criteria – To be awarded to an individual who graduated from Mt. Vernon High School and has enrolled in the HRH School of Radiologic Technology.

The scholarship will be based on the following criteria.

- Academic Standing
- School/Community Involvement

Selection – The scholarship recipient(s) may be selected annually by the Hancock Regional Hospital Foundation Scholarship Committee and the Director of the School of Radiologic Technology.

Scholarship – The amount of the scholarship will cover the student's full tuition and books for two years of the program, as long as the student remains in good academic standing in the school. The scholarship will be paid directly to the HRH School of Radiologic Technology.

Deadline- Applications should be mailed or delivered in person to the Foundation office by 4pm on May 10th of each year.
